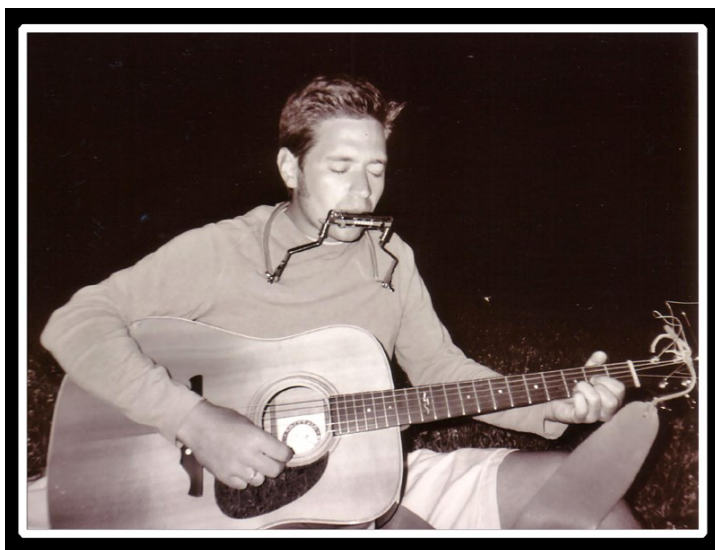


ADRIAN JAMES

Started on my moms vintage 60's Alvarez Classical. I enjoy unique and unorthodox players, like Jimi Hendrix, Neil Young, Ben Harper, and Bob Dylan. So I didn't want a formal training and purposely didn't learn many cover songs. Over the years I've picked up a few, but can probably only play about 5 covers by memory. I was more interested in finding my own sound and songwriting. I literally picked up a guitar learned two chords and wrote a song. A terrible song, but a song, and that's always been my approach and passion. At this point I've written probably close to 1000 songs. I've picked up many things over the years from guys I've played with and the people I've listened to, but have tried to steer clear of the standard or copying an artist. You can still hear my influences, those artists are forever in my ethos, but the exploration continues. I'm still as excited about creation today as I was when I began.
